## PEACE OFFICER HONOURS

### **PURPOSE**

The Union of National Employees recognizes the importance of honouring fallen police and peace officers who are killed in the line of duty. This honour allows members of our union to participate in paying homage to their fallen colleagues. This honour is jointly coordinated with Parks Canada.

### **CRITERIA**

A maximum of 8 members will be able to attend the memorial ceremony (4 funded by Parks Canada and 4 funded by the UNE).

1. These individuals must be UNE members in good standing.
2. They must be a certified peace officer.
3. They must provide a letter stipulating their rationale for attending the peace memorial.
4. They must also provide a briefing note with their claim submission.

### **PROCESS**

1. Parks Canada will initiate the process with a callout letter to the peace officer community.
2. Members wishing to participate will complete the accompanying application form.
3. Applications must be supported by the Local and a regional vice president or an assistant regional Vice President.
4. The selection process will involve a discussion between the UNE national president and the Parks Canada director of law enforcement. Selections will be determined by consensus.
5. In the case of an exceptional circumstance, a business case must be made to the RVP/ARVP and they, in turn, to the president regarding additional attendees.
6. The national president or a designate will attend this event as a representative of the Union of National Employees.
